## **2022 World Leader Program Application Information**

World Leaders provide the first official welcome to all new international University of Georgia students and help them prepare for a successful beginning on campus. This position provides a unique opportunity to have a positive impact on newly admitted international students while also developing leadership, communication, and teamwork skills. World Leaders work closely with ISL staff to ensure a successful orientation. The opportunity to work closely on a team with a select group of fellow student leaders is the most challenging and potentially rewarding aspect of the World Leader experience.

### **Position Requirements**

This position is available to all UGA students to include undergraduate, graduate, or professional students. Students may only serve as a World Leader for two (2) years. A World Leader may only serve a third year if selected for the Senior World Leader role.

### **Being a World Leader**

Being a World Leader means to effectively support international students in their transition to the United States. You'll work closely with ISL staff, Senior World Leaders, and other students to ensure a successful program while having the chance to create and establish relationships with peers and other students and staff. You will provide leadership, guidance, and support while serving as a role model to incoming students. During orientation, you will have high energy, attention to detail, and take initiative to ensure every student has a positive experience. You will also have an open mind, positive attitude, and have flexibility – while being ready to welcome students to UGA!

### **Application Process & Timeline**

Applications will be available beginning early October online at <http://isl.uga.edu>. Your application will include basic demographic information, your resume, and a chance for you to show ISL staff who you are and your interest in the role. All applications are due Friday, December 3 at 5:00PM EST – incomplete applications will not be accepted. Applicants invited for interviews will be contacted via UGA email by mid-December. Individual interviews will be held in early January. Signups for these interviews will be provided to applicants invited for an interview.
